## **ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS**

- 1. Start by finding a good location on your net to attach the new zip-door.
- 2. The opening in the net will need to be the height of the zipper opening on the zip-door (approximately 5 feet in height)
- 3. To cut the opening begin at the bottom of the net and work your way up to the height needed. Use sharp scissors or cutting blade. Cut in the middle of each mesh and cut upward in a straight line. Do not cut near the knot of the mesh or corner of the mesh on knotless nets.
- 4. Attach the zip-door by holding the front opening of the door on the outside entrance of the net and the zip-door back panel on the inside of the net.
- 5. Attach by firmly pressing the Velcro together and aligning the snaps to secure together through the netting.
- 6. The zip-door is now ready to be used. Please be sure the zipper is in the closed position when the net is in use to prevent balls from leaving the batting tunnel areas.

**WARNING:** The zipper on the zipper-door must be in the closed position when batting tunnel net is in use. Please inspect the zipper prior to use to insure proper closure for safety. **DO NOT ENTER THROUGH ZIP DOOR WHILE THE CAGE IS IN USE.**
